A compound word is created when two or more root words are combined to form a new word. A compound in linguistics is a lexeme made up of many stems. The process of word construction that results in compound lexemes is known as compounding, composition, or nominal composition. When two or more words or signs are combined to create a longer word or symbol, it is known as compounding.

When two or more words join to create a single word or a phrase that functions as a single word, the result is a compound word. Ice cream, firefighter, and up-to-date are a few examples of common compound terms. A compound word is created by joining two or more words, including hyphens. It communicates a unit notion that could be more rapidly communicated by the constituent words in an unconnected succession.

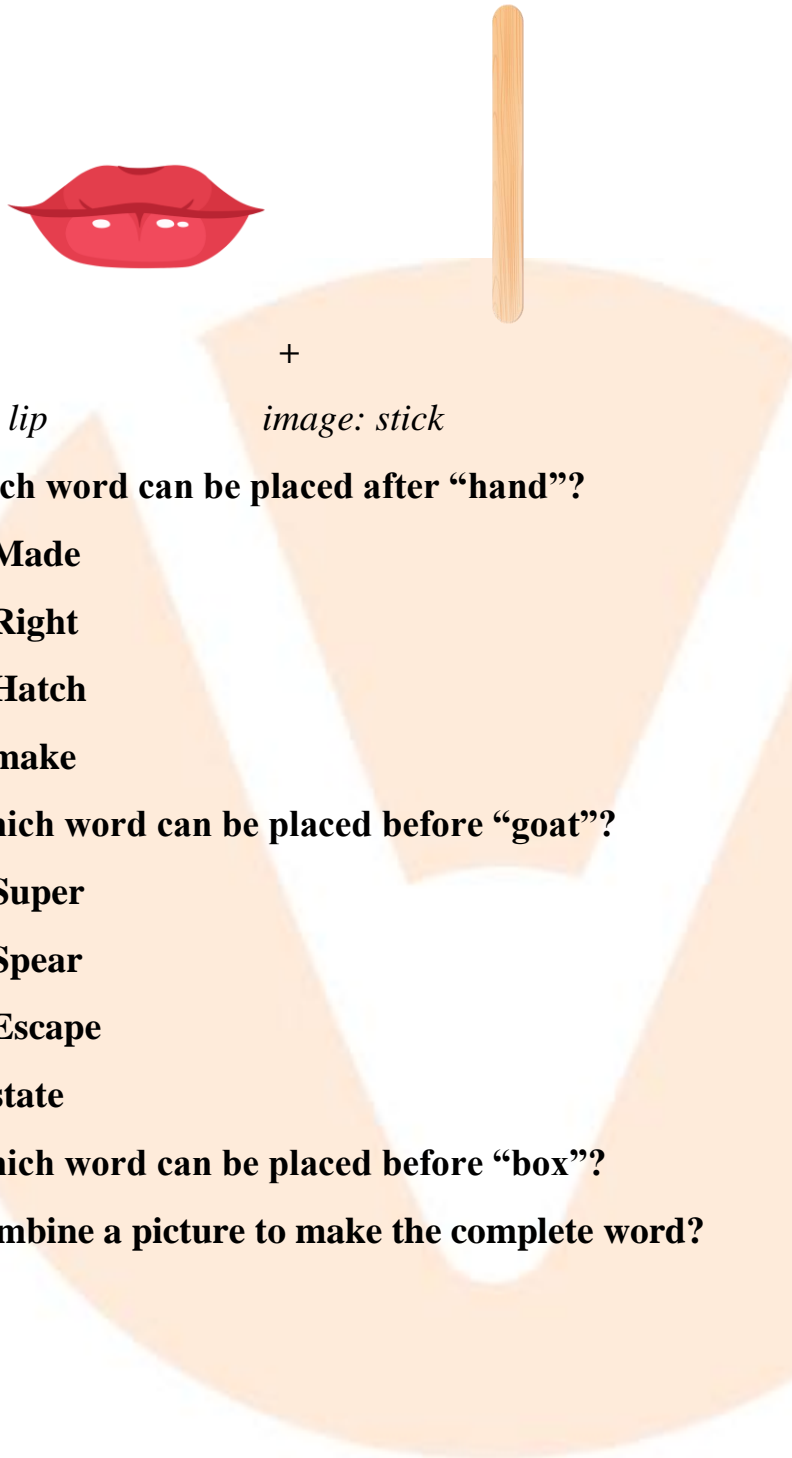

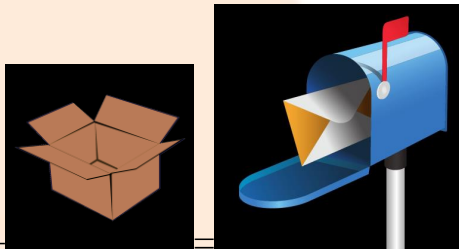
